LoizidouEffective control by TurkeySubordinate local administration

Recognition of title deeds of Republic of Cyprus (RoC)

**ECtHR** • Right of Individual Petition: Art. 35 ECHR

Exhaustion of domestic remedies

Demopoulos v. Turkey, 2010 Judgment on admissibility

Immovable Property Commission (IPC) not incompatible with ECHR

• Effectiveness issue, still open

Xenides – Aresti Group. Judgments about €50 mil.

IPC - Accepts certificates of RoC

Remedies: Restitution, Exchange, Compensation

Joannou v. Turkey: 2 Properties Restitution, 3 Properties

Compensation £215.000 (Pending)

Skourides, Larnacas tis Lapithou: Restitution

Awards: £300 mil. Compensation paid, only £200 mil.

Procedure still ineffective
